

SHAW DANCE STUDIO and PRESCHOOL Safety and Sanitation Procedures



ILLNESS PROTOCOL

- Please do not come to the studio if you have had a cough, fever, or are sick.
- Please do not come to the studio if you have tested positive, or have had COVID- like symptoms in the past 14 days.
- Please do not come to the studio if you have had close contact with a person who has tested positive, or has had COVID- like symptoms in the past 14 days.
- Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed in the building.
- If a child says he/she is sick during a class, that child will be masked and isolated while a parent is called for immediate pick up.
- Students will be instructed to cough or sneeze into a tissue. Students seen touching their face will be asked to re-sanitize or wash hands.
- If we are notified of immediate exposure of positive illness, we defer to recommendations by the Health Department.

STUDENTS

- Students must come dressed and ready for dance upon entrance.
- Student shall bring the absolute minimum into the building.
- Student may bring their own water bottle with a resealable lid- for drinks between classes. Drinking fountains will be unavailable.
- Students with multiple classes in one day, that are not back to back, must leave the studio, or may wait socially distanced in the preschool room if wait time is less than 15 minutes.

FACE MASKS

- A cloth face mask will be provided to all Shaw Dance students for use in our studio or elsewhere.
- Shaw staff will be directed to wear a face covering when physical distancing is not possible.
- Students are not required to wear face coverings when actively engaged in dancing and performing that prevent the wearing of face coverings.
- A student may wear a face covering during class if desired.

FOYER/STUDIO

- The foyer/studio will be limited to students and staff, and the front desk will only be open to parents for supplies or immediate questions.
- All parents guardians, siblings and family members must wait outside the studio.
- Everyone entering the building will be symptom checked and must use hand sanitizer.
- All lost and found items will be disposed of at the end of each day.
- Dancers should use the restroom prior to dance class; however, if a dancer must use the restroom during class, staff will assure that hands are washed prior to returning to dance class.

CLASSES/STUDIO ROOMS

- Due to social dis-DANCING, class size will be limited, and registration is first-come, first served basis.
- All recreation class dancers will be spaced six feet apart while dancing.
- All recreation classes are staggered to provide for social distancing in the hallways.
- Competitive team dancers will follow guidelines as set for youth participating in competitive activities, which allows for closer contact if symptom checked prior to participation.
- All dancers will sanitize feet/shoes prior to walking into each dance studio.
- All dancers will sanitize hands upon exiting each studio.

CLEANING/SANITIZING

- All commonly touched surfaces in the building will be cleaned at least once per hour.
- Barres and any props used in dance class will be sanitized before and after use.
- Dance floors will be sanitized in between each class, or between new groups of dancers.
- Dance bags will be allowed in the dance rooms, not touching others' bags.

PROCEDURES

- **Parents DO NOT ENTER the building with their dancer except to purchase supplies or for immediate questions.**
- **Students when dropped off, should enter the front door only.**
- **Student symptom check and sanitize upon entrance.**
- **Students may arrive no more than five minutes earlier than scheduled class.**
- **Students are to wait on the taped markers in the foyer until escorted to class.**
- **Students will sanitize feet upon entrance into each studio.**
- **Students will sanitize hands upon exiting each dance room.**
- **ALL students will exit the building through the east door (Minnie's door- please close).**
- **All students will be picked up in front of the building on the south sidewalk- all younger children will be escorted outside.**
- **Parents MUST walk up to sidewalk to get kids, and MUST be on time.**
- **Students in multiple classes will sanitize hands after each class, but will move from class to class without congregating in the hallways.**

PRESCHOOL SPECIFIC ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES

- **Preschool staff will wear masks or shields while within six feet proximity of children.**
- **Preschoolers are NOT required to wear masks, but may do so if the parent chooses.**
- **After sanitizing upon entrance into the building, children will sanitize hands prior to using a pencil or crayon.**
- **Only hard toys will be used.**
- **All writing utensils and toys will be sanitized after each class.**
- **All treats brought to be shared for birthdays, etc. must be store bought- individually wrapped.**
